Established in 2023

ARTICLE 1: NAME AND ADDRESS

The organization shall be known as GREAT DESTINIES FOUNDATION, herein referred to as 'the Foundation'. Its registered office shall be located in Buloba, Wakiso District, Uganda.

ARTICLE 2: VISION

A community where every youth and child with mental health challenges or disabilities receives understanding, support, and opportunity to thrive.

ARTICLE 3: MISSION

To promote mental health awareness among the youth and support children with mental disabilities through community and school-based programs.

ARTICLE 4: OBJECTIVES

1. To create awareness about mental health among the youth.
2. To provide psychosocial support to children with mental disabilities.
3. To collaborate with schools and community leaders in supporting inclusion.
4. To advocate for policies that promote mental wellness and inclusion.
5. To empower caregivers and teachers with knowledge on mental health management.

ARTICLE 5: MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all individuals who share the vision and mission of the Foundation regardless of gender, race, or religion. Members shall pay a subscription fee as determined by the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE 6: GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

The Foundation shall be governed by a Board of Directors composed of not less than five (5) and not more than nine (9) members. The day-to-day activities shall be managed by an Executive Committee consisting of the Chairperson, Secretary, and Treasurer.

ARTICLE 7: MEETINGS

The Annual General Meeting (AGM) shall be the supreme decision-making body. The Executive Committee shall meet quarterly to plan and review programs.

ARTICLE 8: FINANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

The Foundation ' s funds shall come from membership fees, donations, grants, and fundraising activities. The Treasurer shall maintain accurate financial records, which shall be audited annually.

ARTICLE 9: AMENDMENTS

This Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of members present at an Annual General Meeting or a special meeting convened for that purpose.

ARTICLE 10: DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the property and assets of the Foundation shall be transferred to another organization with similar objectives, as decided by the members at a general meeting.
